A BILL

To provide that certain regulations shall have the force and effect of enacted law.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Teach Relevant Ap-
5 prenticeships to Drive Economic Success Act” or the
6 “TRADES Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. LEGAL EFFECT.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The provisions of part 29 of title
9 29, Code of Federal Regulations, relating to industry-rec-
10 ognized apprenticeship programs, as amended by the final

1 regulations entitled “Apprenticeship Programs, Labor
2 Standards for Registration, Amendment of Regulations”
3 published by the Department of Labor in the Federal Reg-
4 ister on March 11, 2020 (85 Fed. Reg. 14294 et seq.)
5 shall have the force and effect of enacted law.

6 (b) FUNDING.—Amounts appropriated to carry out
7 the Act of August 16, 1937 (commonly known as the “Na-
8 tional Apprenticeship Act”; 50 Stat. 664, chapter 663; 29
9 U.S.C. 50 et seq.) shall also be made available to carry
10 out the provisions described in subsection (a).
