A BILL

To require the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration to issue regulations that establish minimum requirements for aviation enterprise resource planning systems, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Flightmare Prevention
5 Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR AVIATION INFOR-**
2 **MATION TECHNOLOGY SYSTEMS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the
5 Federal Aviation Administration shall issue regulations
6 that establish minimum requirements for aviation enter-
7 prise resource planning systems that are—

8 (1) used by air carriers operating interstate air
9 transportation or intrastate air transportation; and

10 (2) necessary for the safety of passengers.

11 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

12 (1) AVIATION ENTERPRISE RESOURCE PLAN-
13 NING SYSTEM.—The term “aviation enterprise re-
14 source planning system” means a technology system
15 or software used by air carriers for operational man-
16 agement, including for—

17 (A) crew planning;

18 (B) crew communication;

19 (C) building daily, monthly, and annual
20 flight schedules;

21 (D) making changes to flight paths; and

22 (E) other purposes, as determined by the
23 Secretary

1 (2) TITLE 49.—The definitions contained in
2 section 40102(a) of title 49, United States Code,
3 apply.
