AN ACT

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to provide an alternative manner of furnishing certain health insurance coverage statements to individuals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Paperwork Burden Re-
3 duction Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. ALTERNATIVE MANNER OF FURNISHING CERTAIN**
5 **HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE STATE-**
6 **MENTS TO INDIVIDUALS.**

7 (a) REPORTING OF HEALTH INSURANCE COV-
8 ERAGE.—Section 6055(c) of the Internal Revenue Code
9 of 1986 is amended by adding at the end the following
10 new paragraph:

11 “(3) ALTERNATIVE MANNER OF FURNISHING
12 STATEMENTS.—For purposes of this subsection, any
13 person required to make a return under subsection
14 (a) shall be treated as timely furnishing the written
15 statement required under paragraph (1) if—

16 “(A) such person provides clear, con-
17 spicuous, and accessible notice (at such time
18 and in such manner as the Secretary may pro-
19 vide) that any individual to whom a statement
20 would otherwise be required to be furnished
21 under paragraph (1) may request a copy of
22 such statement, and

23 “(B) such person, on request of any such
24 individual, furnishes a copy of such statement
25 to such individual not later than the later of—

1 “(i) January 31 of the year following
2 the calendar year for which the return
3 under subsection (a) was required to be
4 made, or
5 “(ii) 30 days after the date of such
6 request.”.

7 (b) CERTAIN EMPLOYERS REQUIRED TO REPORT ON
8 HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE.—Section 6056(c) of
9 such Code is amended by adding at the end the following
10 new paragraph:

11 “(3) ALTERNATIVE MANNER OF FURNISHING
12 STATEMENTS.—For purposes of this subsection, any
13 person required to make a return under subsection
14 (a) shall be treated as timely furnishing the written
15 statement required under paragraph (1) if—
