Mr. VALADAO (for himself and Mr. ROBERT GARCIA of California) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

A BILL

To amend the SUPPORT for Patients and Communities Act to expand required reports on T-MSIS substance use disorder data to include mental health condition data.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANDING REQUIRED REPORTS ON T-MSIS**
4 **SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER DATA TO IN-**
5 **CLUDE MENTAL HEALTH CONDITION DATA.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1015(a) of the SUP-
7 PORT for Patients and Communities Act (42 U.S.C.
8 1320d–2 note) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (2)—

2 (A) in the matter preceding subparagraph
3 (A), by inserting “, including as updated in ac-
4 cordance with paragraph (3),” after “paragraph
5 (1)”;

6 (B) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “or
7 mental health condition” after “substance use
8 disorder”;

9 (C) in subparagraph (B), by inserting
10 “and mental health treatment services” after
11 “substance use disorder treatment services”;

12 (D) in subparagraph (C)—

13 (i) by inserting “or mental health con-
14 dition” after “substance use disorder diag-
15 nosis”; and

16 (ii) by inserting “or mental health
17 treatment services, respectively,” after
18 “substance use disorder treatment serv-
19 ices”;

20 (E) in subparagraph (D), by inserting “or
21 mental health condition” after “substance use
22 disorder diagnosis”;

23 (F) in subparagraph (E), by inserting “or
24 mental health treatment” after “substance use
25 disorder treatment”; and

1 (G) in subparagraph (F), by inserting “,
2 and individuals with a mental health condition
3 who receive mental health treatment services,”
4 after “substance use disorder treatment serv-
5 ices”; and

6 (2) in paragraph (3), by striking “through
7 2024”.

8 (b) APPLICATION.—The amendments made by sub-
9 section (a)(1) shall apply beginning with respect to the
10 first update made pursuant to section 1015(a)(3) of the
11 SUPPORT for Patients and Communities Act (42 U.S.C.
12 1320d–2 note) after the date that is 12 months after the
13 date of the enactment of this Act.
