3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “_____ Act of
5 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. MONITORING AND EDUCATION REGARDING INFEC-**
2 **TIONS ASSOCIATED WITH ILLICIT DRUG USE**
3 **AND OTHER RISK FACTORS.**

4 Section 317N of the Public Health Service Act (42
5 U.S.C. 247b–15) is amended—

6 (1) in the section heading, by striking “**SUR-**
7 **VEILLANCE AND**” and inserting “**MONITORING**
8 **AND**”; and

9 (2) in subsection (d), by striking “fiscal years
10 2019 through 2023” and inserting “fiscal years
11 2024 through 2028”.

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
