AN ACT

To prohibit the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency from finalizing, implementing, or enforcing a proposed rule with respect to emissions from vehicles, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Choice in Automobile
3 Retail Sales Act of 2023”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION AGAINST FINALIZING, IMPLE-**
5 **MENTING, OR ENFORCING A PROPOSED RULE**
6 **WITH RESPECT TO EMISSIONS FROM VEHI-**
7 **CLES.**

8 The Administrator of the Environmental Protection
9 Agency may not finalize, implement, or enforce the pro-
10 posed rule titled “Multi-Pollutant Emissions Standards
11 for Model Years 2027 and Later Light-Duty and Medium-
12 Duty Vehicles” published by the Environmental Protec-
13 tion Agency in the Federal Register on May 5, 2023 (88
14 Fed. Reg. 29184).

15 **SEC. 3. ENSURING TAILPIPE REGULATIONS DO NOT LIMIT**
16 **THE AVAILABILITY OF NEW MOTOR VEHI-**
17 **CLES.**

18 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 202(a)(2) of the Clean
19 Air Act (42 U.S.C. 7521(a)(3)) is amended—

20 (1) by striking “(2) Any regulation” and insert-
21 ing “(2)(A) Any regulation”; and

22 (2) by adding at the end the following:

23 “(B) Any regulation proposed or prescribed, in-
24 cluding any revision to a regulation, under para-
25 graph (1) on or after January 1, 2021, shall not—

“(ii) result in limited availability of new motor vehicles based on the type of new motor vehicle engine in such new motor vehicles.”.

(b) NECESSARY REVISIONS TO REGULATIONS.—Not later than 24 months after the date of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agency shall promulgate such revisions to regulations as may be necessary to conform such regulations to section 202(a)(2)(B) of the Clean Air Act, as added by subsection (a).
