A BILL

To extend the authorization of the Chemical Facility Anti-Terrorism Standards Program of the Department of Homeland Security.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Protecting and Securing*
5 *Chemical Facilities from Terrorist Attacks Act of 2023”.*

6 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF AUTHORIZATION OF CHEMICAL FA-**
7 **CILITY ANTI-TERRORISM STANDARDS PRO-**
8 **GRAM OF THE DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND**
9 **SECURITY.**

10 *Section 5 of the Protecting and Securing Chemical Fa-*
11 *cilities from Terrorist Attacks Act of 2014 (Public Law*
12 *113–254; 6 U.S.C. 621 note) is amended by striking “2023”*
13 *and inserting “2025”.*

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
