AN ACT

To amend the Coastal Barrier Resources Act to create an exemption for certain shoreline borrow sites.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. FEDERAL COASTAL STORM RISK MANAGEMENT**
2 **PROJECTS.**

3 Section 6(a) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16
4 U.S.C. 3505(a)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(7) Use of a sand source within a System unit
7 by Federal coastal storm risk management projects
8 or their predecessor projects that have used a sys-
9 tem unit for sand to nourish adjacent beaches out-
10 side the System pursuant to section 5 of the Act of
11 August 18, 1941 (commonly known as the ‘Flood
12 Control Act of 1941’) (55 Stat. 650, chapter 377;
13 33 U.S.C. 701n) at least once between December
14 31, 2008 and December 31, 2023 in response to an
15 emergency situation prior to December 31, 2023.”.
