A BILL

To prohibit Federal funding of Planned Parenthood
Federation of America.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protect Funding for
5 Women’s Health Care Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

2 Congress finds as follows:

3 (1) State and county health departments, com-
4 munity health centers, hospitals, physicians' offices,
5 and other entities currently provide, and will con-
6 tinue to provide, health services to women. Such
7 health services include relevant diagnostic laboratory
8 and radiology services, well-child care, prenatal and
9 postpartum care, immunization, family planning
10 services including contraception, sexually trans-
11 mitted disease testing, cervical and breast cancer
12 screenings, and referrals.

13 (2) Many such entities provide services to all
14 persons, regardless of the person's ability to pay,
15 and provide services in medically underserved areas
16 and to medically underserved populations.

17 (3) All funds no longer available to Planned
18 Parenthood Federation of America will continue to
19 be made available to other eligible entities to provide
20 women's health care services.

21 **SEC. 3. PROHIBITION.**

22 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
23 sion of law, no Federal funds may be made available to
24 Planned Parenthood Federation of America, or to any of
25 its affiliates, subsidiaries, successors, or clinics.

1 (b) RULES OF CONSTRUCTION.—Nothing in this Act
2 shall be construed to—

3 (1) affect any limitation contained in an appro-
4 priations Act relating to abortion; or

5 (2) reduce overall Federal funding available in
6 support of women’s health.

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
