Mr. CLEAVER introduced the following bill; which was referred to the

A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Treasury to instruct the United States Executive Director at each international financial institution to use the voice, vote, and influence of the United States to provide financial assistance to countries that receive an influx of civilian, non-combatant displaced persons stemming from the armed conflict that has resulted from Hamas's October 2023 terrorism in Israel, to be used for humanitarian aid for the displaced persons.

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Armed Conflict Migra-
3 tion Act of 2023”.

4 **SEC. 2. UNITED STATES ADVOCACY IN THE INTER-**
5 **NATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS FOR FI-**
6 **NANCIAL ASSISTANCE FOR COUNTRIES THAT**
7 **RECEIVE AN INFLUX OF DISPLACED PER-**
8 **SONS STEMMING FROM THE ARMED CON-**
9 **FLICT THAT HAS RESULTED FROM HAMAS’S**
10 **OCTOBER 2023 TERRORISM IN ISRAEL, TO BE**
11 **USED FOR HUMANITARIAN AID FOR THE DIS-**
12 **PLACED PERSONS.**

13 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Treasury
14 shall instruct the United States Executive Director at each
15 international financial institution (as defined in section
16 1701(c)(2) of the International Financial Institutions Act)
17 to use the voice, vote, and influence of the United States
18 to support the provision of financial assistance to coun-
19 tries that receive an influx of civilian, non-combatant dis-
20 placed persons stemming from the armed conflict that has
21 resulted from Hamas’s October 2023 terrorism in Israel,
22 to be used for humanitarian aid for the displaced persons.

23 (b) SUNSET.—This section shall cease to have any
24 force or effect on the earlier of—

25 (1) the date that is 7 years after the date of en-
26 actment of this section;

1 (2) the date on which the Secretary of the
2 Treasury certifies to the Committee on Financial
3 Services of the House of Representatives and the
4 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs
5 of the Senate that the requirement under subsection
6 (a) is not in the national interest of the United
7 States; and

8 (3) the date on which the Secretary of the
9 Treasury certifies to the Committee on Financial
10 Services of the House of Representatives and the
11 Committee on Banking, Housing, and Urban Affairs
12 of the Senate that the armed conflict that has re-
13 sulted from Hamas's October 2023 terrorism in
14 Israel has ceased to be a cause of an influx of civil-
15 ian, non-combatant displaced persons to other coun-
16 tries.

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
