A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend incentive payments for participation in eligible alternative payment models.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENDING INCENTIVE PAYMENTS FOR PAR-**
4 **TICIPATION IN ELIGIBLE ALTERNATIVE PAY-**
5 **MENT MODELS.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1833(z) of the Social Se-
7 curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1395l(z)) is amended—

8 (1) in paragraph (1)—

1 (A) in subparagraph (A)—

2 (i) by striking “In the case” and in-
3 serting “Subject to subparagraph (E), in
4 the case”;

5 (ii) by striking “ending with 2025”
6 and inserting “ending with 2026”; and

7 (iii) by inserting “and 2026” after
8 “with respect to 2025”; and

9 (B) by adding at the end the following new
10 subparagraph:

11 “(E) SPECIAL PAYMENT RULE FOR 2026.—
12 With respect to an amount payable under sub-
13 paragraph (A) for 2026 to an eligible profes-
14 sional who is a qualifying APM participant for
15 such year, such amount shall be reduced, in the
16 case such participant has received payment
17 under such subparagraph—

18 “(i) for at least 4 years but fewer
19 than 7 years, by 34 percent; or

20 “(ii) for 7 years, by 67 percent.”;

21 (2) in paragraph (2)—

22 (A) in subparagraph (B)—

23 (i) in the subparagraph heading, by
24 striking “2025” and inserting “2026”; and

1 (ii) in the matter preceding clause (i),
 2 by striking “2025” and inserting “2026”;
 3 (B) in subparagraph (C)—

4 (i) in the subparagraph heading, by
 5 striking “2026” and inserting “2027”; and

6 (ii) in the matter preceding clause (i),
 7 by striking “2026” and inserting “2027”;
 8 and

9 (C) in subparagraph (D), by striking
 10 “2024, and 2025” and inserting “2024, 2025,
 11 and 2026”; and

12 (3) in paragraph (4)(B), by striking “2025”
 13 and inserting “2025 and 2026”.

14 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—Section
 15 1848(q)(1)(C)(iii) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
 16 1395w–4(q)(1)(C)(iii) is amended—

17 (1) in subclause (II), by striking “2025” and
 18 inserting “2026”; and

19 (2) in subclause (III), by striking “2026” and
 20 inserting “2027”.

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
