A BILL

To amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend the Medicare independence at home medical practice demonstration program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXTENDING THE MEDICARE INDEPENDENCE**
4 **AT HOME DEMONSTRATION PROGRAM.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1866E(e) of the Social
6 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395cc–5(e)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “10-year” and
8 inserting “12-year”; and

1 (2) by striking “tenth” each place such term
2 appears and inserting “twelfth” in each such place.

3 (b) REPORT.—Not later than 1 year after the date
4 of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Health and
5 Human Services shall submit to Congress a report on the
6 Independence at Home Medical Practice Demonstration
7 Program established under section 1866E of the Social
8 Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1395cc–5). Such report shall con-
9 tain an evaluation of—

10 (1) the effectiveness of such Program with re-
11 spect to health outcomes; and

12 (2) any barriers to participation in such Pro-
13 gram.

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
