- 15 SEC. 3. PREVENTION AND CONTROL OF INJURIES.
- Section 394A(b) of the Public Health Service Act (42)
- 17 U.S.C. 280b–3(b)) is amended by striking "fiscal years
- 18 2020 through 2024" and inserting "fiscal years 2025
- 19 through 2029".
- 20 SEC. 4. STATE GRANTS FOR PROJECTS REGARDING TRAU-
- 21 MATIC BRAIN INJURY.
- Section 1252 of the Public Health Service Act (42
- 23 U.S.C. 300d–52) is amended—
- 24 (1) in subsection (c)(1), by striking "that is not
- less than \$1 for each \$2 of Federal funds provided

1	under the grant." and inserting the following: "that
2	is—
3	"(A) for fiscal years 2020 through 2024,
4	not less than \$1 for each \$2 of Federal funds
5	provided under the grant; and
6	"(B) for fiscal year 2025 and each suc-
7	ceeding fiscal year, not less than \$0.50 for each
8	\$2 of Federal funds provided under the grant.";
9	(2) by striking subsection (e);
10	(3) by redesignating subsections (f) through (i)
11	as subsections (e) through (h), respectively;
12	(4) by amending subsection (g)(2), as so redes-
13	ignated, to read as follows:
14	"(2)(A) The term 'traumatic brain injury'
15	means an acquired injury to the brain.
16	"(B) Such term—
17	"(i) does not include brain dysfunc-
18	tion caused by congenital or degenerative
19	disorders, nor birth trauma; and
20	"(ii) may include—
21	"(I) brain injuries caused by an-
22	oxia due to trauma; and
23	"(II) damage to the brain from
24	an internal or external source that re-

1	sults in toxicity, surgery, or vascular
2	disorders not associated with aging.
3	"(C) The Secretary may revise the defini-
4	tion of such term as the Secretary determines
5	necessary, after consultation with States and
6	other appropriate public or nonprofit private
7	entities."; and
8	(5) in subsection (i), as so redesignated, by
9	striking "fiscal years 2020 through 2024" and in-
10	serting "fiscal years 2025 through 2029".
