A BILL

3 **SECTION 1. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

4 It is the sense of Congress that, consistent with title
5 IV of the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity
6 Reconciliation Act of 1996 (8 U.S.C. 1611 et seq.), aliens

1 who are present in the United States without lawful status
2 under the immigration laws (as such term is defined in
3 section 101 of the Immigration and Nationality Act (8
4 U.S.C. 1101)) should not receive any benefit under the
5 Medicare program or under the Medicaid program.

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
