Mrs. MILLER-MEEKS (for herself and Mr. CARTWRIGHT) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Energy and Commerce

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## A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to ensure the reliability of address information provided under the Medicaid program.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Medicaid Program Im-  
5       provement Act”.

6       **SEC. 2. ENSURING THE RELIABILITY OF ADDRESS INFOR-**  
7                               **MATION PROVIDED UNDER THE MEDICAID**  
8                               **PROGRAM.**

9       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1902(a) of the Social Se-  
10      curity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)) is amended—

1 (1) in paragraph (86), by striking “and” at the  
2 end;

3 (2) in paragraph (87), by striking the period at  
4 the end and inserting “; and”; and

5 (3) by inserting after paragraph (87) the fol-  
6 lowing new paragraph:

7 “(88) beginning January 1, 2026, provide for a  
8 process to regularly obtain address information for  
9 individuals enrolled under such plan (or a waiver of  
10 such plan) from reliable data sources (as described  
11 in section 435.919 of title 42, Code of Federal Reg-  
12 ulations (or a successor regulation)) and act on any  
13 changes to such an address based on such informa-  
14 tion in accordance with such section (or successor  
15 regulation).”.

16 (b) ENSURING TRANSMISSION OF ADDRESS INFOR-  
17 MATION FROM MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS.—Sec-  
18 tion 1932 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396u–  
19 2) is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-  
20 section:

21 “(j) TRANSMISSION OF ADDRESS INFORMATION.—  
22 Beginning January 1, 2026, each contract under a State  
23 plan with a managed care entity under section 1903(m)  
24 shall provide that the entity transmits to the State any  
25 address information for an individual enrolled with the en-

- 1 tity that is provided to such entity directly from, or
- 2 verified by such entity directly with, such individual.”.

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
