A BILL

To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to ensure the reliability of address information provided under the Medicaid program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
 2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Medicaid Program Im-*
 5 *provement Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. ENSURING THE RELIABILITY OF ADDRESS INFOR-**
 7 **MATION PROVIDED UNDER THE MEDICAID**
 8 **PROGRAM.**

9 *(a) IN GENERAL.—Section 1902(a) of the Social Secu-*
 10 *rity Act (42 U.S.C. 1396a(a)) is amended—*

11 *(1) in paragraph (86), by striking “and” at the*
 12 *end;*

13 *(2) in paragraph (87), by striking the period at*
 14 *the end and inserting “; and”; and*

15 *(3) by inserting after paragraph (87) the fol-*
 16 *lowing new paragraph:*

17 *“(88) beginning January 1, 2026, provide for a*
 18 *process to regularly obtain address information for*
 19 *individuals enrolled under such plan (or a waiver of*
 20 *such plan) from reliable data sources (as described in*
 21 *section 435.919(f)(1)(iii) of title 42, Code of Federal*
 22 *Regulations (or a successor regulation)) and act on*
 23 *any changes to such an address based on such infor-*
 24 *mation in accordance with such section (or successor*
 25 *regulation), except that this paragraph shall only*

1 *apply in the case of the 50 States and the District of*
 2 *Columbia.”.*

3 ***(b) APPLICATION TO CHIP.***—*Section 2107(e)(1) of the*
 4 *Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1397gg(e)(1)) is amended—*

5 *(1) by redesignating subparagraphs (H) through*
 6 *(U) as subparagraphs (I) through (V), respectively;*
 7 *and*

8 *(2) by inserting after subparagraph (G) the fol-*
 9 *lowing new subparagraph:*

10 *“(H) Section 1902(a)(88) (relating to regu-*
 11 *larly obtaining address information for enroll-*
 12 *ees).”.*

13 ***(c) ENSURING TRANSMISSION OF ADDRESS INFORMA-***
 14 ***TION FROM MANAGED CARE ORGANIZATIONS.***—*Section*
 15 *1932 of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396u–2) is*
 16 *amended by adding at the end the following new subsection:*

17 ***(j) TRANSMISSION OF ADDRESS INFORMATION.***—*Be-*
 18 *ginning January 1, 2026, each contract under a State plan*
 19 *with a managed care entity under section 1903(m) shall*
 20 *provide that the entity transmits to the State any address*
 21 *information for an individual enrolled with the entity that*
 22 *is provided to such entity directly from, or verified by such*
 23 *entity directly with, such individual.”.*

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
