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## A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of Transportation from conditioning the receipt of Federal financial assistance on reducing the dimensions of a runway, an apron, or a taxiway of certain airports, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Runway Integrity and  
5 Military Readiness Act of 2024”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON CERTAIN RUNWAY LENGTH RE-**  
2 **QUIREMENTS.**

3       Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-  
4 retary of Transportation may not require an airport to  
5 shorten the length or width of the runway, apron, or taxi-  
6 way of the airport as a condition for the receipt of Federal  
7 financial assistance if the airport directly supports a base  
8 of the United States Air Force or the Air National Guard  
9 at the airport, regardless of the stationing of military air-  
10 craft.

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
