A BILL

To require person convicted of unlawful activity on the campus of an institution of higher education beginning on and after October 7, 2023, to provide community service in Gaza.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Antisemitism Commu-
5 nity Service Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COMMUNITY SERVICE REQUIREMENT.**

7 Any person convicted of unlawful activity on the cam-
8 pus of an institution of higher education beginning on and

1 after October 7, 2023, shall be assigned to Gaza for the
2 purpose of providing community service (as such term is
3 defined in 20 U.S.C. 1070c–4), for a period not fewer than
4 six months.

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
