A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to evaluate certain minerals for designation as critical minerals.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Phosphate and Potash*
5 *Protection Act of 2024”.*

6 **SEC. 2. EVALUATION OF CERTAIN MINERALS FOR DESIGNA-**

7 **TION AS CRITICAL MINERALS.**

8 (i) *IN GENERAL.—Not later than 30 days after the*
9 *date of the enactment of this section, the Secretary, in con-*
10 *sultation with the Secretary of Agriculture, shall evaluate*
11 *potash, phosphates, and other minerals necessary for the*
12 *production of fertilizer and other agricultural products used*
13 *to promote crop development for designation as critical*
14 *minerals under section 7002(c)(4) of the Energy Act of 2020*
15 *(30 U.S.C. 1606(c)(4)).*

16 (ii) *RECOMMENDATIONS.—Not later than 90 days after*
17 *the date of the enactment of this section, the Secretary, in*
18 *consultation with the Secretary of Agriculture, shall—*

19 (1) *evaluate policies in place as of the date of the*
20 *enactment of this section related to the permitting*
21 *and leasing of projects for the exploration, develop-*
22 *ment, and production of the minerals described in*
23 *subsection (a); and*

1 (2) submit to the appropriate congressional com-
2 mittees recommendations to support the domestic pro-
3 duction of such minerals.

4 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 90 days after the date
5 of the enactment of this section, the Secretary, in consulta-
6 tion with the Secretary of Agriculture, shall submit to the
7 appropriate congressional committees a report regarding
8 the evaluation carried out under subsection (a), including
9 a description of how each mineral described in subsection
10 (a) does or does not meet each requirement of the designa-
11 tion methodology to determine the eligibility of each such
12 mineral for inclusion on the critical minerals list.

13 (d) DESIGNATION.—If, pursuant to the evaluation car-
14 ried out under subsection (a), the Secretary, in consulta-
15 tion with the Secretary of Agriculture, determines that a min-
16 eral described in subsection (a) meets each requirement of
17 the designation methodology, the Secretary, in consulta-
18 tion with the Secretary of Agriculture and not later than 45
19 days after the date on which the report required under sub-
20 section (c) is submitted, shall designate such mineral as a
21 critical mineral under section 7002(c)(4) of the Energy Act
22 of 2020 (30 U.S.C. 1606(c)(4)) and update the critical min-
23 erals list accordingly.

24 (e) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

1 (1) *APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-*
2 *TEES.*—*The term “appropriate congressional commit-*
3 *tees” means—*

4 (A) *the Committee on Natural Resources*
5 *and the Committee on Agriculture of the House*
6 *of Representatives; and*

7 (B) *the Committee on Energy and Natural*
8 *Resources and the Committee on Agriculture,*
9 *Nutrition, and Forestry of the Senate.*

10 (2) *CRITICAL MINERAL.*—*The term “critical*
11 *mineral” has the meaning given the term in section*
12 *7002(a) of the Energy Act of 2020 (30 U.S.C.*
13 *1606(a)).*

14 (3) *CRITICAL MINERALS LIST.*—*The term “crit-*
15 *ical minerals list” means the list of critical minerals*
16 *published under section 7002(c)(3) of the Energy Act*
17 *of 2020 (30 U.S.C. 1606(c)(3)).*

18 (4) *DESIGNATION METHODOLOGY.*—*The term*
19 *“designation methodology” means the methodology*
20 *published under section 7002(c)(3) of the Energy Act*
21 *of 2020 (30 U.S.C. 1606(c)(3)) as of the date of the*
22 *enactment of this section.*

23 (5) *SECRETARY.*—*The term “Secretary” means*
24 *the Secretary of the Interior.*

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
