A BILL

To prohibit the Secretary of the Treasury from implementing
or continuing a free, public electronic tax return-filing
service option.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “IRS Overreach Preven-
5 tion Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF FREE DIRECT FILE PROGRAMS.**

7 The Secretary of the Treasury (or the Secretary’s
8 delegate) may not continue the Direct File program of the
9 Internal Revenue Service, and may not develop or provide

- 1 to taxpayers any successor program which provides a free,
- 2 public electronic return-filing service option.
