Mr. KEAN of New Jersey introduced the following bill; which was referred to
the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To suspend compliance of reporting requirements related to
the Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Treaty on Conven-
5 tional Armed Forces in Europe Reform Act”.

6 **SEC. 3. SUSPENSION OF COMPLIANCE OF REPORTING RE-**
7 **QUIREMENTS RELATED TO THE TREATY ON**
8 **CONVENTIONAL ARMED FORCES IN EUROPE.**

9 (a) IN GENERAL.—During the relevant period, the
10 President shall not be required to submit reports on the

1 United States’ or other States Parties’ compliance or non-
2 compliance with the CFE Treaty pursuant to section
3 403(a) of the Arms Control and Disarmament Act (22
4 U.S.C. 2593a(a)) or Conditions 5(C) and 5(D) of the Sen-
5 ate’s resolution of advice and consent to ratification of the
6 CFE Treaty Flank Document Agreement.

7 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—

8 (1) the term “CFE Treaty” means the Treaty
9 on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe, done at
10 Paris, November 19, 1990; and

11 (2) the term “relevant period” means the pe-
12 riod beginning on January 1, 2022, and ending on
13 the date on which the United States has suspended
14 the operation of the CFE Treaty between the United
15 States and every other State Party in accordance
16 with international law.

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
