A BILL

To amend the Congressional Budget and Impoundment Control Act of 1974 to require the Congressional Budget Office to provide baseline updates, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Increasing Baseline
5 Updates Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. CONGRESSIONAL BUDGET OFFICE UPDATES TO**
7 **BASELINE.**

8 Section 202(e) of the Congressional Budget and Im-
9 poundment Control Act of 1974 (2 U.S.C. 602(e)) is
10 amended by adding at the end the following:

11 “(4)(A) The Director shall, to the extent prac-
12 ticable, submit to the Committees on the Budget of
13 the House of Representatives and the Senate at
14 least two updates to the baseline submitted under
15 paragraph (1). At least one of the updates shall in-
16 clude economic data used by the Director to cal-
17 culate such update.

18 “(B) Nothing in this paragraph shall be con-
19 strued to limit the Director from providing any other
20 update to the baseline during such year.”.

21 **SEC. 3. ANNUAL TECHNICAL BUDGET DATA SUBMISSION BY**
22 **THE PRESIDENT.**

23 Section 1106 of title 31, United States Code, is
24 amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(d) On or before February 1 of each calendar year,
2 the President shall submit to Congress technical budget
3 data for the fiscal year beginning in the ensuing calendar
4 year, which shall include up-to-date estimates for current
5 year and prior year data and credit reestimates for the
6 current year (as included in the Federal credit supplement
7 of such budget).”.

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
