RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 115) to amend chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code, to provide for en bloc consideration in resolutions of disapproval for “midnight rules”, and for other purposes.”

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 115) to amend chapter 8 of title 5, United States Code,
4 to provide for en bloc consideration in resolutions of dis-
5 approval for “midnight rules”, and for other purposes. All
6 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.

1 The amendment in the nature of a substitute rec-
2 ommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed
3 in the bill shall be considered as adopted. The bill, as
4 amended, shall be considered as read. All points of order
5 against provisions in the bill, as amended, are waived. The
6 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
7 bill, as amended, and on any further amendment thereto
8 to final passage without intervening motion except: (1) one
9 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair
10 and ranking minority member of the Committee on the
11 Judiciary or their respective designees; and (2) one motion
12 to recommit.

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
