1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Military Mental Health
5 Professionals Support Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION OF LICENSED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH**
2 **PROVIDERS FROM AUTHORIZED STRENGTH**
3 **LIMITATIONS.**

4 Section 523(b)(3) of title 10, United States Code, is
5 amended by inserting “, including licensed behavioral
6 health providers” after “Medical officers”.

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
