Mr. RUBIO (for himself and Mr. SCOTT of Florida) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Indian Affairs

A BILL

To amend the Miccosukee Reserved Area Act to authorize the expansion of the Miccosukee Reserved Area and to carry out activities to protect structures within the Osceola Camp from flooding, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Miccosukee Reserved
5 Area Amendments Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. MICCOSUKEE RESERVED AREA ADDITION.**

2 Section 4(4) of the Miccosukee Reserved Area Act
3 (16 U.S.C. 410 note; Public Law 105–313) is amended
4 by adding at the end the following:

5 “(C) ADDITIONAL AREA.—In addition to
6 the land described in subparagraph (B), the
7 term ‘Miccosukee Reserved Area’ or ‘MRA’ in-
8 cludes the portion of the Park that is known as
9 ‘Osceola Camp’ and is depicted on the map en-
10 titled ‘Everglades National Park, Proposed Ex-
11 pansion–Miccosukee Reserved Area, Osceola
12 Camp’, numbered 160/188443, and dated July
13 2023, copies of which shall—

14 “(i) be kept available for public in-
15 spection in the offices of the National Park
16 Service; and

17 “(ii) be filed with appropriate officers
18 of Miami-Dade County and the Tribe.”.

19 **SEC. 3. PROTECTION OF THE OSCEOLA CAMP FROM**
20 **FLOODING.**

21 Section 8 of the Miccosukee Reserved Area Act (16
22 U.S.C. 410 note; Public Law 105–313) is amended by
23 adding at the end the following:

24 “(j) PROTECTION OF OSCEOLA CAMP FROM FLOOD-
25 ING.—

1 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 2 years
2 after the date of enactment of this subsection, the
3 Secretary, in consultation with the Tribe, shall take
4 appropriate actions to protect structures within the
5 area described in section 4(4)(C) from flooding.

6 “(2) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—
7 There are authorized to be appropriated to the Sec-
8 retary such sums as are necessary to carry out para-
9 graph (1) for fiscal year 2024 and each fiscal year
10 thereafter, but not more than a total \$14,000,000.”.

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
