3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Armenian Protection
5 Act of 2023”.

8 Title II of the Foreign Operations, Export Financing,
9 and Related Programs Appropriations Act, 2002 (Public

2 the heading “ASSISTANCE FOR THE INDEPENDENT
3 STATES OF THE FORMER SOVIET UNION”, in subsection
4 (g)—

- 5 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “(1)”;
6 (2) by striking paragraphs (2) through (6); and
7 (3) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) through
8 (F) as paragraphs (1) through (6), respectively.

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
