A BILL

To reauthorize the program for strengthening communities of recovery for individuals with substance use disorders.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Strengthening Commu-
5 nities of Recovery Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. STRENGTHENING COMMUNITIES OF RECOVERY.**

7 Section 547 of the Public Health Service Act (42
8 U.S.C. 290ee–2) is amended—

9 (1) in the section heading, by striking “**BUILD-**
10 **ING**” and inserting “**STRENGTHENING**”;

1 (2) in subsection (d)(2)(A), in the matter pre-
2 ceding clause (i), by inserting “or strengthen” after
3 “build”; and

4 (3) in subsection (f), by striking “\$5,000,000
5 for each of fiscal years 2019 through 2023” and in-
6 serting “\$16,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2024
7 through 2028”.

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
