A BILL

To eliminate certain requirements with respect to dredging and dredged material, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Incentivizing the Ex-
5 pansion of U.S. Ports Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. DREDGING; DREDGED MATERIAL.**

7 (a) DREDGING.—Section 55109(a)(3) of title 46,
8 United States Code, is amended—

9 (1) by striking “, or is exempt” and inserting
10 “, is exempt”; and

1 (2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
 2 ing “, or is otherwise eligible for such a certificate
 3 and endorsement without regard to the requirement
 4 under section 12112(a)(2)”.

5 (b) EXCLUDING DREDGED MATERIAL FROM TRANS-
 6 PORTATION REQUIREMENTS.—

7 (1) IN GENERAL.—Section 55110 of title 46,
 8 United States Code, is amended—

9 (A) in the section heading, by striking “**OR**
 10 **DREDGED MATERIAL**”; and

11 (B) by striking “or dredged material”.

12 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—The analysis
 13 for chapter 551 of title 46, United States Code, is
 14 amended by striking the item relating to section
 15 55110 and inserting the following:

“Sec. 55110. Transportation of valueless material.”.
