Mr. HAGERTY introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security and Governmental Affairs

A BILL

To require the head of each agency to submit to Congress and make publicly available information relating to the implementation of Executive Order 14019.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AGENCY INFORMATION.**

4 (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

5 (1) AGENCY.—The term “agency”—

6 (A) has the meaning given the term in sec-
7 tion 3502 of title 44, United States Code; and

1 (B) does not include an independent regu-
2 latory agency (as defined in section 3502 of
3 title 44, United States Code).

4 (2) IMPLEMENTATION PLAN.—The term “im-
5 plementation plan” means—

6 (A) a strategic plan of an agency required
7 under section 3(b) of Executive Order 14019
8 (86 Fed. Reg. 13623; relating to promoting ac-
9 cess to voting); and

10 (B) any other plan of an agency for imple-
11 menting Executive Order 14019 (86 Fed. Reg.
12 13623; relating to promoting access to voting).

13 (b) AGENCY REQUIREMENT.—Not later than 30 days
14 after the date of enactment of this Act, the head of each
15 agency shall submit to Congress and make publicly avail-
16 able a report that includes—

17 (1) a copy of each implementation plan of the
18 agency;

19 (2) a status update and timeline on the imple-
20 mentation of each implementation plan of the agen-
21 cy; and

22 (3) the date on which the head of the agency
23 expects to substantially complete the implementation
24 of each implementation plan of the agency.

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
