A BILL

To amend the Water Resources Development Act of 1992
to provide for environmental infrastructure in coastal
Georgia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Coastal Georgia Flood-
5 ing Prevention Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. COASTAL GEORGIA.**

7 Section 219(f) of the Water Resources Development
8 Act of 1992 (106 Stat. 4835; 113 Stat. 334; 136 Stat.
9 3808) is amended by adding at the end the following:

1 “(406) COASTAL GEORGIA.—\$5,000,000 for en-
2 vironmental infrastructure, including water and
3 wastewater infrastructure (including stormwater
4 management), Glynn County, Chatham County,
5 Bryan County, Effingham County, McIntosh Coun-
6 ty, and Camden County, Georgia.”.

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
