To require retrofitting of anti-lock brake system and electronic stability control kit for certain Army vehicles.

Mr. PETERS (for himself and Mr. COTTON) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

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## A BILL

To require retrofitting of anti-lock brake system and electronic stability control kit for certain Army vehicles.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. RETROFITTING OF ANTI-LOCK BRAKE SYSTEM**  
4                   **AND ELECTRONIC STABILITY CONTROL KIT**  
5                   **FOR CERTAIN ARMY VEHICLES.**

6       (a) REQUIREMENT.—By not later than September  
7     30, 2030, the Secretary of the Army shall ensure that all  
8     high-mobility multipurpose wheeled vehicles identified in  
9     the Tactical Wheeled Vehicle Strategy of the Army have

1 been retrofitted with an anti-lock brake system and elec-  
2 tronic stability control kit.

3 (b) PLAN.—

4 (1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of the Army  
5 shall develop a plan to ensure the requirement under  
6 subsection (a) will be met.

7 (2) ELEMENTS OF PLAN.—The plan required  
8 under paragraph (1) shall include the following:

9 (A) A description of the steps required to  
10 ramp up production of the anti-lock brake sys-  
11 tem and electronic stability control kits required  
12 under subsection (a) and conduct retrofitting  
13 activities at Red River Army Depot, Texas, and  
14 its associated flyaway teams.

15 (B) A list of challenges identified by the  
16 Secretary of the Army, if any, to meeting the  
17 requirement under subsection (a) and a list of  
18 steps required to address those challenges.

19 (C) An estimated monthly rate of retrofits  
20 needed to meet the requirement under sub-  
21 section (a).

22 (D) A funding plan required to carry out  
23 the steps described in subparagraphs (A) and  
24 (B).

1                                 (E) An identification of any authorities or  
2                                 funding required for secondary destination  
3                                 transportation to fulfill the plan required under  
4                                 paragraph (1).

5                                 (3) SUBMISSION OF PLAN.—Not later than 90  
6                                 days after the date of the enactment of this Act, the  
7                                 Secretary of the Army shall submit to the congres-  
8                                 sional defense committees the plan required by para-  
9                                 graph (1).

10                                 (c) ANNUAL CERTIFICATION.—Not later than each of  
11                                 March 1, 2026, March 1, 2027, and March 1, 2028, the  
12                                 Secretary of the Army shall certify to the congressional  
13                                 defense committees that the budget of the Army will en-  
14                                 able the Army to meet the requirement under subsection  
15                                 (a).

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
