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# A BILL

To amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to allow Indian tribal governments to directly request fire management assistance declarations and grants, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1   **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “Fire Management As-  
 3       sistance Grants for Tribal Governments Act”.

4   **SEC. 2. INDIAN TRIBAL GOVERNMENT ELIGIBILITY.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 420 of the Robert T.  
 6       Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act  
 7       (42 U.S.C. 5187) is amended—

8               (1) in subsection (a), by inserting “, Indian  
 9       tribal government,” before “or local government”;

10              (2) by redesignating subsections (b) through (e)  
 11       as subsections (c) through (f), respectively;

12              (3) by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-  
 13       lowing:

14              “(b) PROCEDURE FOR REQUEST.—The Governor of  
 15       a State or the Chief Executive of an Indian tribal govern-  
 16       ment affected by a fire described in subsection (a) may  
 17       directly submit a request to authorize assistance under  
 18       this section.”; and

19              (4) by adding at the end the following:

20              “(g) SAVINGS PROVISION.—Nothing in this section  
 21       shall prohibit an Indian tribal government from receiving  
 22       assistance under this section pursuant to an authorization  
 23       made at the request of a State under subsection (b) if  
 24       assistance is not authorized under this section for the  
 25       same incident based on a request by the Indian tribal gov-  
 26       ernment under subsection (b).”.

1       (b) REGULATIONS.—

2           (1) FIRE MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE DECLARA-  
3       TION DEFINED.—In this subsection, the term “fire  
4       management assistance declaration” means a de-  
5       claration approved under section 204.21(a) of title  
6       44, Code of Federal Regulations.

7           (2) UPDATE.—Not later than 360 days after  
8       the date of enactment of this Act, the President  
9       shall issue regulations updating part 204 of title 44,  
10      Code of Federal Regulations, to carry out the  
11      amendments made by subsection (a).

12           (3) CONTENTS.—In issuing the regulations re-  
13       quired under paragraph (2), the President shall—

14               (A) authorize the Federal Emergency Man-  
15       agement Agency to directly receive a request for  
16       a fire management assistance declaration from  
17       an Indian tribal government and directly pro-  
18       vide related grants and resources to Indian trib-  
19       al governments;

20               (B) clarify that Indian tribal governments  
21       for which the President does not grant a re-  
22       quest described in subparagraph (A) remain eli-  
23       gible to receive assistance under section 420 of  
24       the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and  
25       Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5187)

1           through assistance granted under a fire man-  
2           agement assistance declaration made at the re-  
3           quest of a State;

4           (C) consider the unique conditions that af-  
5           fect the general welfare of Indian tribal govern-  
6           ments; and

7           (D) enter into government-to-government  
8           consultation with Indian tribal governments re-  
9           garding the regulations.

10 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

11         *This Act may be cited as the “Fire Management Assist-  
12 ance Grants for Tribal Governments Act”.*

13 **SEC. 2. INDIAN TRIBAL GOVERNMENT ELIGIBILITY.**

14         (a) *IN GENERAL.—Section 420 of the Robert T. Staf-  
15 ford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42  
16 U.S.C. 5187) is amended—*

17           (1) *in subsection (a), by inserting “, Indian trib-  
18 al government,” before “or local government”;*

19           (2) *by redesignating subsections (b) through (e)  
20 as subsections (c) through (f), respectively;*

21           (3) *by inserting after subsection (a) the fol-  
22 lowing:*

23         “(b) *PROCEDURE FOR REQUEST.—The Governor of a  
24 State or the Chief Executive of an Indian tribal government  
25 affected by a fire described in subsection (a) may directly*

1 submit a request to authorize assistance under this sec-  
2 tion.”; and

3 (4) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(g) *SAVINGS PROVISION.*—Nothing in this section  
5 shall prohibit an Indian tribal government from receiving  
6 assistance under this section pursuant to an authorization  
7 made at the request of a State under subsection (b) if assist-  
8 ance is not authorized under this section for the same inci-  
9 dent based on a request by the Indian tribal government  
10 under subsection (b).”.

11 (b) *REGULATIONS.*—

12 (1) *FIRE MANAGEMENT ASSISTANCE DECLARA-*  
13 *TION DEFINED.*—In this subsection, the term “fire  
14 management assistance declaration” means a declara-  
15 tion approved under section 204.21(a) of title 44,  
16 *Code of Federal Regulations.*

17 (2) *UPDATE.*—Not later than 1 year after the  
18 date of enactment of this Act, the President shall issue  
19 regulations updating part 204 of title 44, *Code of*  
20 *Federal Regulations,* to carry out the amendments  
21 made by subsection (a).

22 (3) *CONTENTS.*—In issuing the regulations re-  
23 quired under paragraph (2), the President shall—

24 (A) authorize the *Federal Emergency Man-*  
25 *agement Agency* to directly receive a request for

1           *a fire management assistance declaration from*  
2           *an Indian tribal government and directly pro-*  
3           *vide related grants and resources to Indian trib-*  
4           *al governments;*

5           *(B) clarify that Indian tribal governments*  
6           *for which the President does not grant a request*  
7           *described in subparagraph (A) remain eligible to*  
8           *receive assistance under section 420 of the Robert*  
9           *T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency As-*  
10          *sistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5187) through assistance*  
11          *granted under a fire management assistance dec-*  
12          *laration made at the request of a State;*

13          *(C) consider the unique conditions that af-*  
14          *flect the general welfare of Indian tribal govern-*  
15          *ments; and*

16          *(D) enter into government-to-government*  
17          *consultation with Indian tribal governments re-*  
18          *garding the regulations.*



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
