## A BILL

To strengthen the United States Interagency Council on Homelessness.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS FOR**  
4       **INTERAGENCY COUNCIL ON HOMELESSNESS.**

5       (a) IN GENERAL.—Title II of the McKinney-Vento  
6 Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11311 et seq.) is  
7 amended—

8               (1) in section 208 (42 U.S.C. 11318), by strik-  
9       ing “to carry out this title \$3,000,000 for fiscal year  
10       2010 and such sums as may be necessary for fiscal

1 years 2011” and inserting “such sums as may be  
2 necessary to carry out this title”;

3 (2) by striking section 209 (42 U.S.C. 11319);

4 and

5 (3) by redesignating section 210 (42 U.S.C.  
6 11320) as section 209.

7 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

8 The table of contents in section 101(b) of the McKinney-  
9 Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11301 note)  
10 is amended by striking the items relating to sections 209  
11 and 210 and inserting the following:

“Sec. 209. Encouragement of State involvement.”.
