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# A BILL

To clarify jurisdiction with respect to certain Bureau of Reclamation pumped storage development, and for other purposes.

- 1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
- 2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
- 3       **SECTION 1. LAND WITHDRAWAL AND RESERVATION.**
- 4       (a) **DEFINITIONS.**—In this section:

1                   (1) AGREEMENT.—The term “Agreement”  
2 means the agreement between the United States and  
3 the Association dated September 6, 1917.

4                   (2) ASSOCIATION.—The term “Association”  
5 means the Salt River Valley Water Users’ Association.  
6

7                   (3) COVERED LAND.—The term “covered land”  
8 means the portion of the National Forest System  
9 land located on the south side of the Salt River from  
10 the March 9, 1903, 1-mile withdrawal area for Re-  
11clamation purposes extending an additional 2 miles  
12 from the Salt River at Roosevelt Dam to 18.25 river  
13 miles downstream, not including the Superstition  
14 Mountain Wilderness Area and the Tonto National  
15 Monument, as depicted on the Map.

16                   (4) DISTRICT.—The term “District” means the  
17 Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and  
18 Power District.

19                   (5) MAP.—The term “Map” means the map  
20 prepared under subsection (e)(1).

21                   (6) SRP.—The term “SRP” means—  
22                         (A) the District; and  
23                         (B) the Association.

24                   (b) RESERVATION OF COVERED LAND.—Subject to  
25 valid existing rights, the covered land is reserved to the

1 United States, through the Secretary of the Interior, for  
2 the exclusive right to use the covered land and interests  
3 in the covered land for the development, generation, and  
4 transmission of electrical power and energy for the use  
5 and benefit of the Salt River Federal Reclamation Project  
6 pursuant to the Agreement.

7 (e) WITHDRAWAL OF COVERED LAND.—The covered  
8 land is permanently withdrawn from—

9 (1) all forms of entry, appropriation, and dis-  
10 posal under the public land laws;

11 (2) location, entry, and patent under the mining  
12 laws; and

13 (3) operation of the mineral leasing, mineral  
14 materials, and geothermal leasing laws.

15 (d) TITLE TO FACILITIES.—With respect to facilities  
16 constructed by SRP on the covered land for the develop-  
17 ment, generation, and transmission of electrical power and  
18 energy—

19 (1) title shall be held by the United States as  
20 part of the Salt River Federal Reclamation Project  
21 pursuant to—

22 (A) section 6 of the Act of June 17, 1902

23 (32 Stat. 389, chapter 1093, 43 U.S.C. 498);

24 and

25 (B) the Agreement; and

1                   (2) SRP shall be responsible for the care, operation,  
2                   and maintenance pursuant to the Agreement.  
3                   (e) MAP.—

4                   (1) IN GENERAL.—As soon as practicable after  
5                   the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of  
6                   Agriculture shall prepare a map depicting the  
7                   boundary of the covered land.

8                   (2) AVAILABILITY.—The Map shall be on file  
9                   and available for public inspection in the appropriate  
10                  offices of the Forest Service and the Bureau of Re-  
11                  clamation.

12 **SECTION 1. LAND WITHDRAWAL AND RESERVATION.**

13                   (a) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:

14                   (1) AGREEMENT.—The term “Agreement” means  
15                   the agreement between the United States and the As-  
16                  sociation dated September 6, 1917, as amended.

17                   (2) ASSOCIATION.—The term “Association”  
18                  means the Salt River Valley Water Users’ Associa-  
19                  tion.

20                   (3) COVERED LAND.—The term “covered land”  
21                  means the portion of the National Forest System land  
22                  located on the south side of the Salt River from the  
23                  March 9, 1903, 1-mile withdrawal area for Bureau of  
24                  Reclamation purposes extending an additional 2  
25                  miles from the Salt River at Roosevelt Dam to 18.25

1       *river miles downstream, in the State of Arizona, not*  
2       *including the Superstition Mountain Wilderness Area*  
3       *and the Tonto National Monument, as depicted on the*  
4       *Map.*

5           (4) *DISTRICT.*—The term “District” means the  
6       *Salt River Project Agricultural Improvement and*  
7       *Power District.*

8           (5) *MAP.*—The term “Map” means the map pre-  
9       pared under subsection (e)(1).

10          (6) *SRP.*—The term “SRP” means—  
11              (A) *the District; and*  
12              (B) *the Association.*

13          (b) *RESERVATION OF COVERED LAND.*—Subject to  
14       *valid existing rights, the covered land is reserved to the*  
15       *United States, through the Secretary of the Interior, for the*  
16       *exclusive right to use the covered land and interests in the*  
17       *covered land for the development, generation, and trans-*  
18       *mission of electrical power and energy for the use and ben-*  
19       *efit of the Salt River Federal Reclamation Project pursuant*  
20       *to the Agreement.*

21          (c) *WITHDRAWAL OF COVERED LAND.*—The covered  
22       *land is permanently withdrawn from—*  
23              (1) *all forms of entry, appropriation, and dis-*  
24              *posal under the public land laws;*

1                   (2) location, entry, and patent under the mining  
2                   laws; and

3                   (3) operation of the mineral leasing, mineral  
4                   materials, and geothermal leasing laws.

5                   (d) FACILITIES.—With respect to facilities constructed  
6 by SRP on the covered land for the development, generation,  
7 and transmission of electrical power and energy—

8                   (1) the design and specifications shall conform to  
9 Bureau of Reclamation standards and final designs  
10 shall be subject to review and approval by the Sec-  
11 retary of the Interior;

12                   (2) all construction work shall be subject to in-  
13 spection and approval by the Secretary of the Inter-  
14 rior;

15                   (3) on a determination of substantial completion  
16 of the applicable facilities, the Secretary of the Inter-  
17 rior shall accept title on behalf of the United States  
18 as part of the Salt River Federal Reclamation Project  
19 pursuant to—

20                   (A) section 6 of the Act of June 17, 1902  
21 (32 Stat. 389, chapter 1093; 43 U.S.C. 498); and

22                   (B) the Agreement; and

23                   (4) SRP shall be responsible for the care, oper-  
24 ation, and maintenance pursuant to the Agreement.

25                   (e) MAP.—

1                   (1) *IN GENERAL.*—As soon as practicable after  
2     the date of enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Ag-  
3     riculture shall prepare a map depicting the boundary  
4     of the covered land.

5                   (2) *AVAILABILITY.*—The Map shall be on file and  
6     available for public inspection in the appropriate of-  
7     fices of the Forest Service and the Bureau of Rec-  
8     lamation.

9                   (f) *MANAGEMENT OF COVERED LAND.*—The covered  
10   land shall be managed in accordance with the memorandum  
11   entitled “Management Memorandum among the Salt River  
12   Project Agricultural Improvement and Power District,  
13   United States Department of Agriculture Forest Service  
14   and United States Bureau of Reclamation” and dated April  
15   27, 1979, as amended.

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
