A BILL

To allow Members of Congress to opt out of the Federal Employees Retirement System, and allow Members who opt out of the Federal Employees Retirement System to continue to participate in the Thrift Savings Plan.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Members of Congress
5 Pension Opt Out Clarification Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. MAKING FERS OPTIONAL FOR MEMBERS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—

11 (b) CONTINUED PARTICIPATION IN TSP.—

12 (1) AMENDMENT.—Section 8401(20) of title 5,
13 United States Code, as amended by subsection (a),
14 is further amended—

(A) by striking “term ‘Member’ has the same meaning as provided in” and inserting the following: “term ‘Member’—

18 “(A) has the meaning given the term ‘Member
19 of Congress’ under”;

20 (B) by inserting “, subject to subparagraph-
21 graph (B),” after “except that”;

22 (C) by adding “and” after the semicolon at
23 the end; and

(D) by adding at the end the following:

1 “(B) for purposes of subchapter III, has the
2 meaning given the term ‘Member of Congress’ under
3 section 2106, without regard to whether the indi-
4 vidual elects not to participate in the Federal Em-
5 ployees’ Retirement System;”.

6 (2) CONFORMING AMENDMENT TO TSP.—Sec-
7 tion 8431(a) of title 5, United States Code, is
8 amended by inserting “except as provided in section
9 8401(20)(B),” after “subchapter.”.

10 (3) APPLICABILITY.—The amendments made
11 by this subsection shall apply with respect to an in-
12 dividual who makes an election described in section
13 8401(20) of title 5, United States Code, not to par-
14 ticipate in the Federal Employees’ Retirement Sys-
15 tem before, on, or after the date of enactment of this
16 Act.
