A BILL

To amend title 5, United States Code, to provide for the halt in pension payments for Members of Congress sentenced for certain offenses, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Congressionally
5 Obligated Recurring Revenue Used as Pensions To Incar-

1 cerated Officials Now Act” or the “No CORRUPTION
2 Act”.

3 **SEC. 2. FORFEITURE OF PENSION.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8332(o) of title 5, United
5 States Code, is amended—

6 (1) by redesignating paragraphs (4), (5), and
7 (6) as paragraphs (5), (6), and (7), respectively;

8 (2) by inserting after paragraph (3) the fol-
9 lowing:

10 “(4)(A) Subject to subparagraph (B), an individual
11 convicted of an offense described in paragraph (2) shall
12 not be eligible to receive any payment of an annuity pursu-
13 ant to the retirement system under this subchapter or
14 chapter 84, except that this sentence applies only to such
15 payments based on service rendered as a Member (irre-
16 spective of when rendered).

17 “(B) If the conviction of an individual described in
18 subparagraph (A) is overturned on appeal by a court of
19 competent jurisdiction, the individual shall receive pay-
20 ments that the individual would have received but for the
21 application of subparagraph (A).

22 “(C) This paragraph applies only to a conviction that
23 occurs after the date of enactment of the No Congression-
24 ally Obligated Recurring Revenue Used as Pensions To
25 Incarcerated Officials Now Act.”;

1 (3) in paragraph (5)(B)(i), as so redesignated,
2 by striking “paragraph (5)” and inserting “para-
3 graph (6)”; and

4 (4) in paragraph (6), as so redesignated, by
5 striking “paragraph (4)(B)” and inserting “para-
6 graph (5)(B)”.

7 (b) TECHNICAL AND CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—
8 Section 719(e)(2) of title 38, United States Code, is
9 amended by striking “section 8332(o)(5)” and inserting
10 “section 8332(o)(6)”.
