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## JOINT RESOLUTION

Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States to reaffirm the principle that no person is above the law.

1       *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*  
2       *of the United States of America in Congress assembled*  
3       *(two-thirds of each House concurring therein),* That the fol-  
4       lowing article is proposed as an amendment to the Con-  
5       stitution of the United States, which shall be valid to all  
6       intent and purposes as part of the Constitution when

1 ratified by the legislatures of three-fourths of the several  
2 States:

3 “ARTICLE —

4 “SECTION 1. ACCOUNTABILITY TO THE LAW. The  
5 Government established by this Constitution is a govern-  
6 ment of laws. Subject to the provisions of the first clause  
7 of section 6 of article I, every person holding a position  
8 of authority under the United States, including the Presi-  
9 dent and the Vice President, is accountable to the law for  
10 their actions, both official and unofficial; every such per-  
11 son is liable to prosecution and punishment in the ordinary  
12 course of law. Laws of general applicability shall be inter-  
13 preted as applicable to the President unless otherwise  
14 specified.

15 “SECTION 2. ENFORCEMENT. This article is self-exe-  
16 cuting. Congress shall have plenary power to make all nec-  
17 essary rules and regulations designed to ensure the gen-  
18 eral applicability and enforcement of criminal laws, includ-  
19 ing by tolling the statute of limitations applicable to a vio-  
20 lation of the law by an incumbent President for the dura-  
21 tion of the term of office of the President.”.

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
