Re: Hearing titled "Oversight of Federal Agencies' Post-Pandemic Telework Policies: Part II"

On Wednesday, October 18, 2023, at 10:00 AM ET in room 2247 of the Rayburn House Office Building, the Subcommittee on Government Operations and the Federal Workforce will host a hearing titled "Oversight of Federal Agencies' Post-Pandemic Telework Policies: Part II."

I. BACKGROUND:

At the onset of the COVID pandemic, federal agencies adopted a maximum telework posture. However, as the risk of COVID receded, federal agencies maintained high rates of telework. The Office of Management and Budget (OMB) and Office of Personnel Management (OPM) published guidance indicating increased telework would remain the norm. In April 2023, OMB issued guidance that called for increased "meaningful" inperson work. The guidance also required agencies to submit plans detailing how they would utilize telework and how they would better measure agency performance.

II. HEARING PURPOSE:

This hearing will examine the reasoning behind, and results of, federal agencies' use of widespread telework following the end of the COVID pandemic.
