### AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to seek to enter into an agreement with a federally funded research and development center for an assessment of notice letters that the Secretary sends to claimants for benefits under laws administered by the Secretary, and for other purposes. Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Clear Communication5 for Veterans Claims Act".

## 6 SEC. 2. INDEPENDENT ASSESSMENT OF NOTICES THAT THE 7 SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SENDS 8 TO CLAIMANTS.

9 (a) AGREEMENT.—Not later than 30 days after the 10 date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Vet-11 erans Affairs shall seek to enter into an agreement with 12 an FFRDC for an assessment of notices that the Sec-13 retary sends to claimants.

(b) ASSESSMENT.—An FFRDC that enters to an
agreement under subsection (a) shall submit to the Secretary a written assessment of such notices. The assessment shall include the following:

(1) The determination of the FFRDC, made in
consultation with covered entities, whether each such
notice may be feasibly altered to reduce paper consumption by, and costs to, the Federal Government.

(2) The recommendations of the FFRDC regarding how the Secretary may make such notices
clearer to claimants, better organized, and more concise.

1	(c) Report; Implementation.—Not later than 90
2	days after the Secretary receives the assessment under
3	subsection (b), the Secretary shall—
4	(1) submit to the Committees on Veterans' Af-
5	fairs of the Senate and House of Representatives a
6	copy of such assessment; and
7	(2) implement the recommendations in the as-
8	sessment that are in compliance with the laws ad-
9	ministered by the Secretary.
10	(d) Deadline for Implementation.—The Sec-
11	retary shall complete the implementation of such rec-
12	ommendations pursuant to subsection $(c)(2)$ by not later
13	than one year after the date on which the Secretary com-
14	mences such implementation.
15	(e) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
16	(1) The term "FFRDC" means a federally
17	funded research and development center.
18	(2) The term "covered entities" includes—
19	(A) the Secretary of Veterans Affairs;
20	(B) an expert in laws administered by the
21	Secretary of Veterans Affairs;
22	(C) a veterans service organization recog-
23	nized under section 5902 of title 38, United
24	States Code;

1	(D) an entity that advocates for veterans;
2	and
3	(E) an entity that advocates for the sur-
4	vivors of veterans.
5	(3) The terms "claimant" and "notice" have
6	the meanings given such terms in section 5100 of
7	title 38, United States Code.
