A BILL

To provide that the special Government employee managing the Department of Government Efficiency shall be liable for any claims against the Federal Government related to Department activities, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Nobody Elected Elon
5 Musk Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PAYMENT OF CLAIMS AGAINST FEDERAL GOVERN-**
2 **MENT RELATED TO DEPARTMENT OF GOV-**
3 **ERNMENT EFFICIENCY ACTIVITIES.**

4 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the spe-
5 cial Government employee (as that term is defined in sec-
6 tion 202(a) of title 18, United States Code) managing or
7 otherwise in charge of the Department of Government Ef-
8 ficiency (or any successor thereof) within the Executive
9 Office of the President shall be liable for any claim against
10 the Federal Government relating to activities of the De-
11 partment, including claims brought as a result of violation
12 of Federal labor laws, data privacy laws, threats to na-
13 tional or domestic security, Federal appropriations laws,
14 or any other statutes.

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
