A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to seek to enter into an agreement with a federally funded research and development center for an assessment of forms that the Secretary sends to claimants for benefits under laws administered by the Secretary, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Simplifying Forms for*
5 *Veterans Claims Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. INDEPENDENT ASSESSMENT OF FORMS THAT THE**
7 **SECRETARY OF VETERANS AFFAIRS SENDS**
8 **TO CLAIMANTS.**

9 (a) *AGREEMENT.*—*Not later than 30 days after the*
10 *date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary of Veterans*
11 *Affairs shall seek to enter into an agreement with an*
12 *FFRDC for an assessment of forms that the Secretary sends*
13 *to claimants.*

14 (b) *ASSESSMENT.*—*An FFRDC that enters to an*
15 *agreement under subsection (a) shall submit to the Sec-*
16 *retary a written assessment, made in consultation with cov-*
17 *ered entities, of such forms. The assessment shall include*
18 *the recommendations of the FFRDC regarding how the Sec-*
19 *retary may make such forms clearer to claimants and better*
20 *organized.*

21 (c) *REPORT; IMPLEMENTATION.*—*Not later than 90*
22 *days after the Secretary receives the assessment under sub-*
23 *section (b), the Secretary shall—*

1 (1) *submit to the Committees on Veterans' Af-*
2 *airs of the Senate and House of Representatives a*
3 *copy of such assessment; and*

4 (2) *implement the recommendations in the as-*
5 *essment that are in compliance with the laws admin-*
6 *istered by the Secretary.*

7 (d) *DEADLINE FOR IMPLEMENTATION.—The Secretary*
8 *shall complete the implementation of such recommendations*
9 *pursuant to subsection (c)(2) by not later than two years*
10 *after the date on which the Secretary commences such im-*
11 *plementation.*

12 (e) *DEFINITIONS.—In this section:*

13 (1) *The term “FFRDC” means a federally fund-*
14 *ed research and development center.*

15 (2) *The term “covered entities” includes—*

16 (A) *the Secretary of Veterans Affairs;*

17 (B) *an expert in laws administered by the*
18 *Secretary of Veterans Affairs;*

19 (C) *a veterans service organization recog-*
20 *nized under section 5902 of title 38, United*
21 *States Code;*

22 (D) *an entity that advocates for veterans;*
23 *and*

24 (E) *an entity that advocates for survivors of*
25 *veterans.*

1 (3) *The term “claimant” has the meaning given*
2 *such term in section 5100 of title 38, United States*
3 *Code.*

4 **SEC. 3. EXTENSION OF CERTAIN LIMITS ON PAYMENTS OF**
5 **PENSION.**

6 *Section 5503(d)(7) of title 38, United States Code, is*
7 *amended by striking “November 30, 2031” and inserting*
8 *“December 31, 2031”.*

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
