AN ACT

To direct the Secretary of Homeland Security to conduct a threat assessment of terrorist threats to the United States posed by individuals in Syria with an affiliation with a Foreign Terrorist Organization or a Specially Designated Global Terrorist Organization, and for other purposes.

1	Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2	tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
3	SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
4	This Act may be cited as the "Syria Terrorism
5	Threat Assessment Act".
6	SEC. 2. THREAT ASSESSMENT OF TERRORIST THREATS
7	POSED BY INDIVIDUALS IN SYRIA WITH AN
8	AFFILIATION WITH A FOREIGN TERRORIST
9	ORGANIZATION OR A SPECIALLY DES
10	IGNATED GLOBAL TERRORIST ORGANIZA
11	TION.
12	(a) Terrorism Threat Assessment.—
13	(1) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland
14	Security, in coordination with the heads of other rel-
15	evant Federal departments or agencies, shall con-
16	duct a threat assessment of terrorist threats to the
17	United States posed by individuals in Syria with an
18	affiliation with a foreign terrorist organization or a
19	specially designated global terrorist organization.
20	(2) Elements.—The threat assessment re-
21	quired under paragraph (1) shall include the fol-
22	lowing:
23	(A) An identification of the country of ori-
24	gin for each such individual included in such
25	threat assessment.

1	(B) A description of the foreign terrorist
2	organization or specially designated global ter-
3	rorist organization with which each such indi-
4	vidual is affiliated.
5	(C) A description of the following:
6	(i) The capability of the Department
7	of Homeland Security to identify, track,
8	and monitor such individuals.
9	(ii) Any associated challenges with
10	such capability.
11	(D) A description of any action of the De-
12	partment with respect to the following:
13	(i) Mitigating the terrorist threats to
14	the United States posed by such individ-
15	uals.
16	(ii) Preventing such individuals from
17	entering the United States.
18	(b) Congressional Notification.—
19	(1) In general.—Not later than 60 days after
20	the date of the enactment of this Act, the Secretary
21	shall—
22	(A) submit to the appropriate congres-
23	sional committees the threat assessment re-
24	quired under subsection (a); and

1	(B) provide a briefing to the appropriate
2	congressional committees on such assessment.
3	(2) FORM.—The threat assessment required
4	under subsection (a) shall be submitted in unclassi-
5	fied form, but may include a classified annex.
6	(c) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:
7	(1) Appropriate congressional commit-
8	TEES.—The term "appropriate congressional com-
9	mittees" means—
10	(A) the Committee on Homeland Security
11	of the House of Representatives; and
12	(B) the Committee on Homeland Security
13	and Governmental Affairs of the Senate.
14	(2) Foreign terrorist organization.—The
15	term "foreign terrorist organization" means an or-
16	ganization designated as a foreign terrorist organiza-
17	tion under section 219 of the Immigration and Na-
18	tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1189).
19	(3) Specially designated global ter-
20	RORIST ORGANIZATION.—The term "specially des-
21	ignated global terrorist organization" means an or-
22	ganization that has been designated as a specially
23	designated global terrorist organization by the Sec-
24	retary of State or the Secretary of the Treasury, as
