A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “American Investment
5 in Manufacturing and Main Street Act” or the “AIMM
6 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT EXTENSION OF ALLOWANCE FOR DE-**
2 **PRECIATION, AMORTIZATION, OR DEPLETION**
3 **IN DETERMINING THE LIMITATION ON BUSI-**
4 **NESS INTEREST.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 163(j)(8)(A)(v) of the In-
6 ternal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking “in
7 the case of taxable years beginning before January 1,
8 2022,”.

9 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
10 this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
11 December 31, 2021.

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
