 - 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the
3 "ThinkDIFFERENTLY About Disability Employment
4 Act".

5 SEC. 2. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING TO INCREASE 6 EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR INDIVID7 UALS WITH DISABILITIES.

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Administrator of the Small
9 Business Administration, in consultation with the Chair
10 of the National Council on Disability, shall—

(1) provide assistance to individuals with disabilities who desire to become entrepreneurs or to be
self-employed;

(2) help individuals with disabilities find employment at small business concerns (as defined
under section 3 of the Small Business Act (15
U.S.C. 632)); and

(3) assist small business concerns with hiring
individuals with disabilities and with accessibility
issues applicable to individuals with disabilities.

(b) MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING OR AGREEMENT.—The Administrator, in consultation with the
Chair, shall carry out and coordinate the activities described in subsection (a) by entering into one or more
memoranda of understanding or other appropriate agreements.

1 (c) OUTREACH AND EDUCATION.—In carrying out 2 the activities described in subsection (a), the Adminis-3 trator, in consultation with the Chair, shall conduct out-4 reach and education about such activities.

5 (d) REPORT.—Not later than two years after the date 6 of the enactment of this Act, the Administrator, in con-7 sultation with the Chair, shall submit to Congress a report 8 on activities carried out pursuant to any memorandum or 9 agreement described in subsection (b) that includes the 10 following:

(1) A description of how the Administrator, in
consultation with the Chair, carried out such activities.

14 (2) An analysis of opportunities to expand the
15 technical capabilities of the Small Business Adminis16 tration in carrying out such activities.

17 (3) A description of achievements under any18 such memorandum or agreement.

(4) A description of the plans of the Administrator, in consultation with the Chair, to continue
activities to expand employment opportunities for individuals with disabilities.

1 SEC. 3. NO ADDITIONAL FUNDS AUTHORIZED.

- 2 No additional funds are authorized to carry out the
- 3 requirements of this Act.
