"(gg) CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION.—The
term 'career and technical education' has the meaning
given the term in section 3 of the Carl D. Perkins Career
and Technical Education Act of 2006 (20 U.S.C. 2302).".
(b) SMALL BUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CENTERS.—
Section 21(c)(3) of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C.

17 (1) in subparagraph (T), by striking "and" at18 the end;

(2) in clause (v) of the first subparagraph (U)
(relating to succession planning), by striking the period at the end and inserting a semicolon;

(3) in second subparagraph (U) (relating to

property protections)—

25 (A) in clause (ii)(II), by striking the period
26 at the end and inserting a semicolon; and

(B) by redesignating such subparagraph as
subparagraph (V); and
(4) by adding at the end the following new sub-
paragraphs:
"(W) providing educational information to
small businesses on—
"(i) hiring graduates from career and tech-
nical education programs; and
"(ii) career and technical education pro-
grams relevant to such businesses, including
how to use such programs to satisfy hiring
needs of such businesses;
"(X) providing information to career and tech-
nical education programs about how students and
graduates of such programs can access resources
and services of small business development centers
to start and expand a small business concern; and
"(Y) as appropriate, connecting small busi-
nesses with career and technical education programs
to assist students and graduates of such programs
with identifying career opportunities.".
(c) Women's Business Centers.—Section 29(b) of
the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 656(b)) is amended—
(1) in paragraph (2), by striking "and" at the
end;
