A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to extend
the energy credit for qualified fuel cell property.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Technology for Energy
5 Security Act”.

6 **SEC. 2 EXTENSION OF ENERGY CREDIT FOR QUALITY FUEL**
7 **CELL PROPERTY.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 48(c)(1)(E) of the Inter-
9 nal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking “Janu-
10 ary 1, 2025” and inserting “January 1, 2033”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 this section shall apply to property the construction of
3 which begins after December 31, 2024.
