A BILL

To amend the National Agricultural Research, Extension, and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 to extend grants and fellowships for food and agricultural sciences education.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Future Funding for
5 Agricultural Research, Mentorship, and Education Reau-
6 thorization Act” or the “Future FARMER Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXTENSION OF GRANTS AND FELLOWSHIPS FOR**
2 **FOOD AND AGRICULTURAL SCIENCES EDU-**
3 **CATION.**

4 Section 1417(m) of the National Agricultural Re-
5 search, Extension, and Teaching Policy Act of 1977 (7
6 U.S.C. 3152(m)) is amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking “and” at the
8 end;

9 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking the period at
10 the end and adding “; and”; and

11 (3) by adding at the end the following:

12 “(3) \$40,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2025
13 through 2029.”.

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
