## AN ACT

To require the District of Columbia to comply with federal  
immigration laws.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2   *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2       This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia  
3 Federal Immigration Compliance Act of 2025”.

4 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA SERVING**  
5 **AS SANCTUARY JURISDICTION.**

6       The District of Columbia may not have in effect a  
7 statute, ordinance, policy, or practice that prohibits or re-  
8 stricts any entity or official of the District government  
9 from—

10           (1) sending, receiving, maintaining, or exchang-  
11 ing with any Federal, State, or local government en-  
12 tity information regarding the citizenship or immi-  
13 gration status (lawful or unlawful) of any individual;  
14 or

15           (2) complying with a request lawfully made by  
16 the Department of Homeland Security under section  
17 236 or 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act  
18 (8 U.S.C. 1226 and 1357) to comply with a detainer  
19 for, or notify about the release of, an individual.
