1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4	SEC. 2. PROHIBITION ON DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA SERVING				
5	AS SANCTUARY JURISDICTION.				
6	The District of Columbia may not have in effect				
7	statute, ordinance, policy, or practice that prohibits or re-				
8	stricts any entity or official of the District government				
9	from—				
10	(1) sending, receiving, maintaining, or exchang-				
11	ing with any Federal, State, or local government en-				
12	tity information regarding the citizenship or imm				
13	gration status (lawful or unlawful) of any individual				
14	or				
15	(2) complying with a request lawfully made by				
16	the Department of Homeland Security under section				
17	236 or 287 of the Immigration and Nationality Act				
18	(8 U.S.C. 1226 and 1357) to comply with a detainer				
19	for, or notify about the release of, an individual.
