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## A BILL

To amend the Federal Water Pollution Control Act with respect to permitting terms, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL POLLUTANT DISCHARGE ELIMI-**  
4 **NATION SYSTEM (NPDES) TERMS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 402(b)(1)(B) of the Fed-  
6 eral Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.  
7 1342(b)(1)(B)) is amended to read as follows:

8 “(B) are for fixed terms—

9 “(i) not exceeding 10 years, for a permit  
10 issued to a State or municipality; and

1 “(ii) not exceeding 5 years, for a permit  
2 issued to any person not described in clause (i);  
3 and”.

4 (b) TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.—Section 402(l)(3) of  
5 the Federal Water Pollution Control Act (33 U.S.C.  
6 1342(l)(3)) is amended—

7 (1) in subparagraph (B)—

8 (A) by striking “section 402” and insert-  
9 ing “this section”; and

10 (B) by striking “federal” and inserting  
11 “Federal”; and

12 (2) in subparagraph (C)—

13 (A) by striking “Section” and inserting  
14 “section”;

15 (B) by striking “402(p)(6)” and inserting  
16 “subsection (p)(6)”;

17 (C) by striking “402(l)(3)(A),” and insert-  
18 ing “subparagraph (A),”; and

19 (D) by striking “402(l)(3)(A).” and insert-  
20 ing “such subparagraph.”.

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
